

Report Exemption Fraud

Florida laws provide for a number of exemptions from property taxes. Sometimes properties receive exemptions they are not entitled to. Your Property Appraiser's office commits a great deal of time and energy regulating these exemptions, but we can't be everywhere all the time. That's where you can help us. Every time someone receives an exemption they shouldn't, the rest of us have to pay. Help us make certain we all pay our fair share and no more. Let us know when you see exemption fraud.

The Property Appraiser's office takes fraud very seriously. Florida law provides for many different penalties, from billing for back taxes to filing liens on the property and criminal prosecution. Help us make sure you are not paying someone else's share of the tax burden by reporting exemption fraud.
